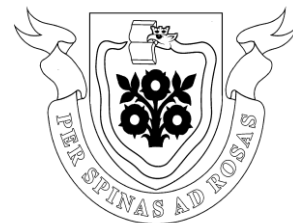

How often do you use the internet?

Travel

Tell me about a place you visited and liked.
What do you usually do when you go on holiday?
What problems can people have when travelling?

Free Time

What do people your age usually do in their free time?
Do you think hobbies are important? Why?
