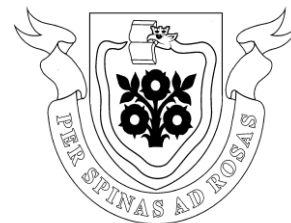

Sample Questions

Part 1: Personal Introduction (Warm-up)

Can you describe an important experience in your life?
How have your interests changed over time?
What are your strengths and weaknesses?
What are your plans for the next few years?

Part 2: Topic-Based Questions

Education

What are the advantages and disadvantages of your school system?
How could schools be improved?
Is it better to study alone or in a group? Why?

Technology

How has technology changed people's lives?
What are the advantages and disadvantages of social media?
Should there be limits on screen time?

Travel & Culture

How does travelling help people learn about other cultures?
What problems can tourists cause in popular places?
Is it better to travel alone or with others? Why?

Society

What makes a good friend?
How can people help their local community?
Do you think young people have a good life today? Why / Why not?

Part 3: Interactive / Role-play Tasks

Task 1: Discussion & Decision-Making

You are planning a school trip.
Discuss different options and agree on the best one.

Task 2: Problem-Solving

Your friend has a problem (e.g. too much homework, stress).
Give advice and discuss possible solutions.

Task 3: Expressing Opinions

Discuss whether students should have more free time.
Give reasons and respond to your partner's ideas.
